The Quasics FRC team has qualified for the first-annual WOW Alliance District Championship. In previous years, this off-season event was the Ohio State Championship, but with the expectation that they will eventually be moving to a District model that will also include teams from Western/Central Pennsylvania and West Virginia, they have opened up the scope of the event to include teams from those areas. Quasics ranked 20th out of the 88 teams in contention, and were honored to accept the invitation to compete in this one-day event on May 27th in Westerville, Ohio at the Rike Center (Otterbein University).



Western PA VEX Championship March 4, 2017

Our VEX teams played in the W.PA VEX State Championship on March 4 at Sarah Heinz House! Both teams finished 5-3-0. 9656A was ranked #7 and was drafted into the #4 Alliance. 9656B was ranked #9 and served as the #6 Alliance Captain. B lost in the Quarterfinals and A lost in the Semifinals.





Greater Pittsburgh FRC Regional March 16-18, 2017

Quasics celebrated our 10th FRC season with an amazing Greater Pittsburgh Regional!! The drive team piloted Nike to a Quasics-best 6-4-1 record and #16 finish. 2656 was drafted in the second round by the #5 Alliance (156 and 302) and narrowly escaped the Quarterfinals before being defeated in the Semifinals by the #1 Alliance and eventual Regional Winners (2252, 359, 3954). Everything at the Regional was vastly improved this season, from our on-field play to our Pit, Safety and Judges materials. We are eagerly looking forward to ten more seasons and so much more!


