But here's some of the highlights of what we've been doing (both on the competition fields and off) since the last time!

Greater Pittsburgh FRC Regional Thursday-Saturday, 22-24 Mar 2018

Season 11 saw Quasics competing in the 2018 FRC Greater Pittsburgh Regional. We went 4-5-0 in our Qualification matches. We were drafted in the second round by the #4 seed alliance: Teams 3171 and 870 (both from New York). We were eliminated in the Quarterfinals tiebreaker match by the #6 Alliance. During the Awards Ceremony, we were presented with the Team Spirit Award, sponsored by the FCA Foundation. And, for the fourth straight season, a Quasics member was named a Dean's List Finalist! Congratulations to Quasics junior Hailey K. on her selection! Hailey attended the FiRST Championship in Detroit, Michigan in late April 2018.

Cub Scouts Pack 90 demo



Demo with Girl Scouts Troop 52635 Friday, 25May2018


