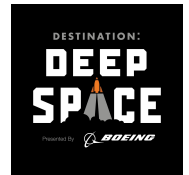
Quasics has recently started demonstrating for the local Girl Scout troops. We have visited Troops 52296, 46590, 52635, 52281, 52232, 52301, 55153, 36789, 46768, 55153, 52296, 52910, and 56148. We led two workshops for the Central Westmoreland Service Unit at their "Full STEAM Ahead" event in July 2018 and another in Monroeville. Since May of 2018, Quasics has inspired a total of 277 Girl Scouts and helped them earn 234 STEM Badges! Our goal is to visit every Girl Scouts Troop in our area, and to inspire as many of them as we can to explore STEM and robotics.

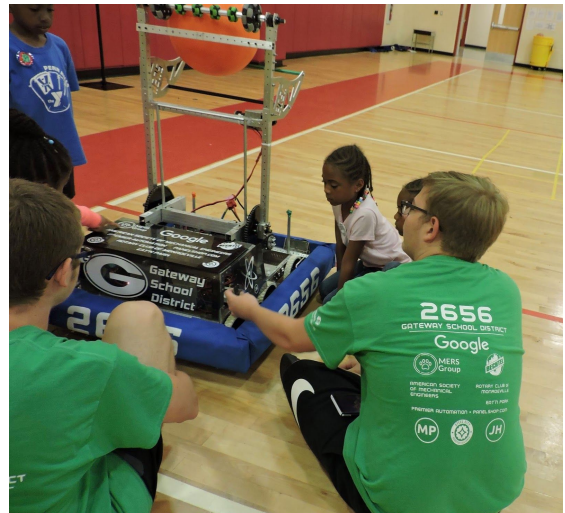
